II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A juvenile resident of Tarzana was assaulted in the 24200 block of Hidden Ridge Road. The victim was at the location to attend a party when four subjects (males, Middle Eastern, 18 years of age) challenged the victim to a fight. The victim walked back to his vehicle to avoid the subjects and noticed that his vehicle had been vandalized. He was then assaulted by one subject with a collapsible hand held baton. The subjects fled in a gray Mercedes C63 vehicle.

The subject (A resident of Pico Rivera) was seen by a security officer pass the security gate and climb the fence in the 6100 block of Spring Valley Road. The subject was told he would be arrested for trespassing if he did not leave the area. The subject refused. When the LASD LHS Mental Evaluation Team responded they determined the subject was a danger to himself and others, and he was transported to a hospital pending a mental health assessment.

A Van Nuys resident was arrested for being “drunk in public” in the area of Long Valley Road.

A resident of Augusta, Georgia, was arrested for trespassing and possession of narcotics in the 5300 block of Lasher Road. The subject had tried to make entry into the community earlier in his vehicle. The subject then returned on foot and attempted to make entry when he was detained.
