**Consideration of Approval of an Urgency Ordinance Regarding the Los Angeles County Local Fire Debris Removal Program Adopting By Reference Portions of The Los Angeles County Woolsey Fire Debris Removal Ordinance and a Memorandum of Understanding Between The County of Los Angeles and The City of Hidden Hills Regarding The Consolidated Debris Removal Program Within The City In Response To The Woolsey Fire**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS APPROVING PARTICIPATION IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY LOCAL FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL PROGRAM, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE PORTIONS OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY WOOLSEY FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF**

City Manager Kallman explained that Los Angeles County Local Health Officer issued a Declaration of a Local Health Emergency and Order Prohibiting the Endangerment of the Community through the Unsafe Removal, Transport and Disposal of Fire Debris (Declaration), and that the State Office of Emergency Services will provide fire debris clearance services primarily to residential property owners in the Woolsey Fire burn area who elect to receive these services. For property owners to participate in this program, the City Council needs to adopt by reference a Fire Debris Removal Ordinance and authorize the City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the Consolidated Removal Program with the County of Los Angeles.

Upon MOTION by Council Member Siegel, seconded by Council Member Weber, and unanimously carried, it was resolved to adopt by title only, Ordinance No. U-370 entitled: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS APPROVING PARTICIPATION IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY LOCAL FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL PROGRAM, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE PORTIONS OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY WOOLSEY FIRE DEBRIS REMOVAL ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF.



Upon MOTION of Council Member Weber, seconded by Council Member Katz and unanimously carried on roll call vote, it was resolved to approve the demand list as submitted.


**ADJOURNMENT**
