II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A residential burglary was reported in the 24100 block of Hidden Ridge. The master bedroom window was smashed to gain entry. No property was stolen. (19-00636)

A residential burglary occurred in the 25100 block of Jim Bridger. Suspect(s) unknown smashed a bedroom window on the first floor, ransacked the master bedroom and exited the residence by smashing a sliding glass door. Jewelry was stolen. (19-00682)

An attempt residential burglary occurred in the 6000 block of William Bent Road. One of the victim's was home when she heard a banging noise from the downstairs Area. Moments later the alarm system in the residence was activated. Video surveillance showed three unknown suspects entering the victim's backyard. The suspects faces were covered with masks and appeared to be canvassing the home. The suspects fled when the alarm activated. No vehicle was seen. (19-00832)

A residential burglary was reported in the 25100 block of Jim Bridger. The downstairs master bedroom sliding glass door was smashed to gain entry and ransacked all the bedrooms. It was unknown what was stolen at the time of the report. (19-00755)

An attempt residential burglary occurred in the 25200 block of El Dorado Meadow. A witness saw three suspects hiding in the bushes in the area. The suspects were described as possibly males who were wearing dark colored clothing and hooded sweatshirts. They fled in a grey 2017 Nissan Rogue which was found abandoned in the on Boda Place in Woodland Hills. The vehicle was a rental vehicle. (19-00868)

A subject was arrested for conspiracy to commit burglary and trespassing in the 6100 block of Spring Valley Road. The witness, a security guard, saw the subject peeking over two residence fences in the area. The subject attempted to hide but the witness was able to detain the subject for deputies pending a burglary investigation. (19-00891)

A theft from an unlocked vehicle was reported in the 24000 block of Long Valley Road. A briefcase, gift cards and check books were stolen. Video surveillance showed two suspects wearing dark clothing and hooded sweatshirts enter the victim's driveway and one suspect making entry into the victim's unlocked vehicle. (19-00862)

A theft of a firearm occurred in the 24000 block of Little Valley Road. The weapon was taken from the night stand. The investigation is on-going. (19-00648)

A resident of Los Angeles was arrested for a traffic violation warrant (driving without a valid driver's license) in the area of Jed Smith Road and John Fremont Road.
