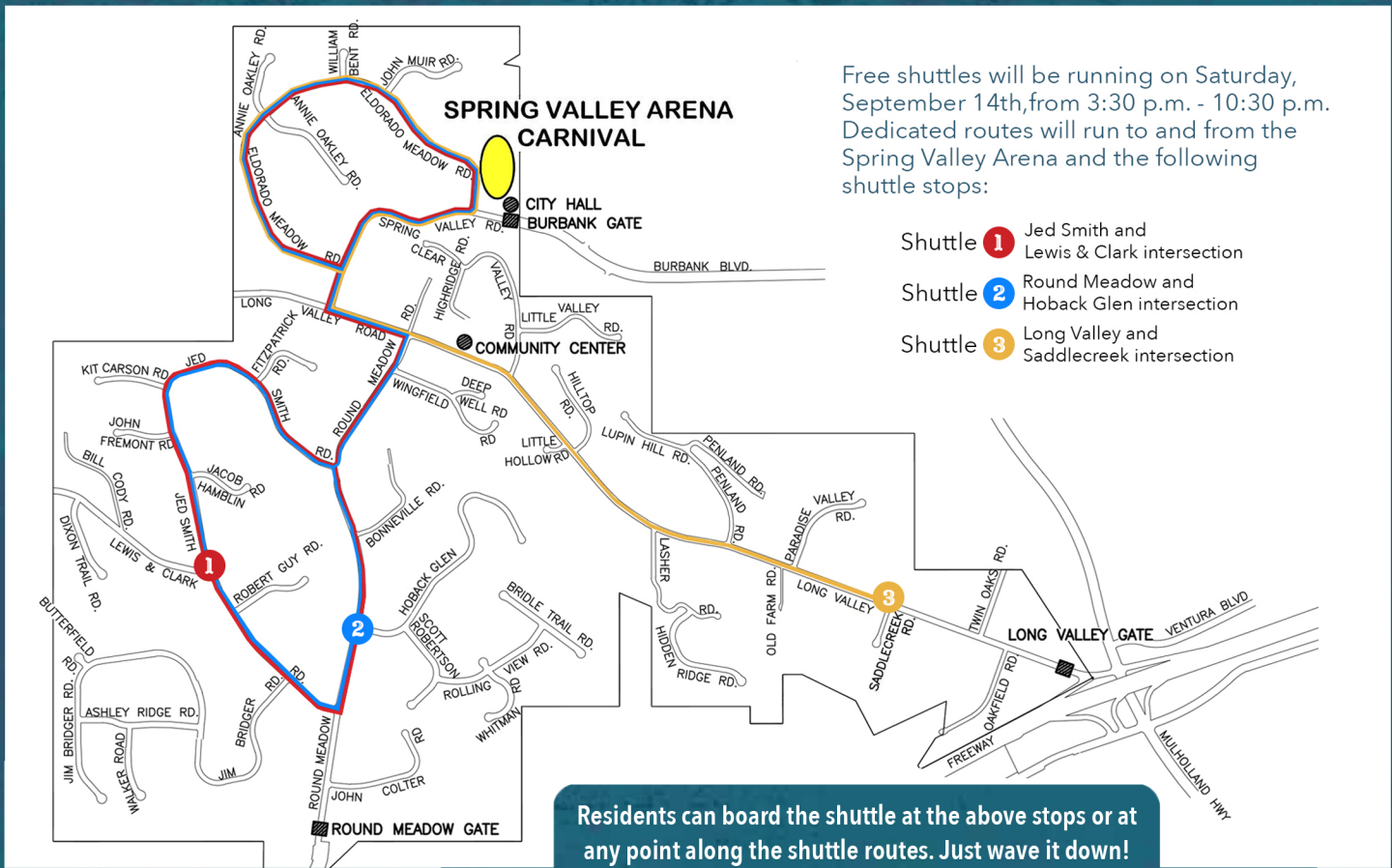

Tickets purchased in person or online must be picked up at City Hall no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, September 13. **Proof of purchase will not gain entry to ticketed events, guests must present actual tickets.**
