NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hidden Hills City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider the following:

An Ordinance amending the Hidden Hills Municipal Code regarding Senate Bill 9 subdivisions and development projects and finding the Ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act Regulations Section 15061(b)(3).
