11. **EMERGENCY SERVICES**

A. Disaster Area B Issues

The individual hired to coordinate Area B is doing well and being trained. There is a new course for NIMS which can be taken on line. Chairman Doran attended a disaster course regarding seniors and animals. A special needs survey will be sent to all seniors within the City. A letter will be sent to all NEAT members asking them to recruit more volunteers. Commissioner Deitch will draft a general letter to be sent to all residents requesting volunteers. Another CPR class will be offered in the future. Chairman Doran would like to schedule another CERT class. A once a week class was suggested with Wednesday being selected as the day. Chairman Doran will check with Fire Department personnel as to their availability for these classes. On Saturday, January 20, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. til noon area assignments and a damage assessment class will be provided to NEAT members. Commissioner Deitch suggested having a set time for radio checks. All Commissioners felt this was a good idea.

B. Automated External Defibrillator (AED) for City Hall - Update
