# 8. <u>L.A. COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT</u>

Activity report for October was received and discussed. It was noted that inspections are ahead of last year.

#### 9. <u>L.A. COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT</u>

Activity report for October was received and discussed. Commissioner Ulrich moved to let residents know of recent incidents (burglaries, etc.) by using the reverse 911 telephone system and to seek feedback from residents. The Motion was seconded by Commissioner Zane. Chairman Doran will check with the Sheriff to see if this is legal and acceptable to them before acting upon the motion.

#### 10. OLD BUSINESS

Commissioner Ulrich requested an update regarding the stop signs on new Eldorado Meadow and John Muir. Commissioner Zane took pictures of these locations. Chairman Doran will check on the cost of conducting a traffic study in this area. Commissioner Zane moved and Commissioner Ulrich seconded to place stop signs on Annie Oakley and Eldorado Meadow, John Muir and Eldorado Meadow, and William Bent and Eldorado Meadow (the last two being three way stops). Chairman Doran can look into the cost and feasibility of a traffic study at these three intersections.

## 11. <u>EMERGENCY SERVICES</u>

#### A. Disaster Area B Issues

The next meeting will be a holiday lunch.

#### B. Disaster Preparedness

The number of radios and other equipment needed was discussed.

- 1. For the ham radio, scanner, new battery and antenna \$1,650.00.
- 2. For a solar panel at the repeater site \$1,900 installed with an extra battery.
- 3. Round Meadow Elementary School will request a grant from the City to purchase their radios.
- 4. The radio at the Community Association has been repositioned. All radios must be reprogrammed for the narrow band.
- 5. Will need 45 new radios, carrying cases and extra batteries, with 2 six bank chargers; the original 25 radios will need to be reprogrammed to the narrow band.

Chairman Doran will obtain a quote from NIDA Corporation and present this to the City Council in December. The Commissioners compared proposals from Citywide and Connect-CTY for new telephone notification systems.
