10. NEW BUSINESS

Based on a letter received from resident Jerry Sprackman, the Commissioners discussed the use of leaf blowers. The Hidden Hills Municipal Code section 3-8-5 J states that only electric leaf blowers may be used within the City. This should be enforced. The Commissioners felt it did not make much sense to use leaf blowers on the dirt/dg parkways, but took no action to address this.

11. EMERGENCY SERVICES

Most of the City and Round Meadow School radios have been returned and narrow-banded as required by law.
